Project Homeless Connect (“PHC”) was founded in San Francisco in 2004 as a one stop model for people experiencing or at-risk of experiencing homelessness.

### **Beginning in Buffalo**

PHC Buffalo began in 2009 as an initiative of the WNY Coalition for the Homeless. Since then this event has served more than 2,200 homeless and at-risk clients.

### **What did PHC Buffalo accomplish last year?**

At our 2015 event:

- More than **500 clients** participated
- **Over 80 local agencies** attended and provided almost **2,000 services**
- Over **3,000 personal care items** were handed out
- **98% of participants** said they would attend this event again

### **Services provided at PHC Buffalo**
