Project Homeless Connect

(PHC) is a one stop model of delivering services to people experiencing or at-risk of experiencing homelessness. PHC began in San Francisco in 2004 and has grown into an international best practice model. This program has shown positive results in getting people connected to the community while providing them services they otherwise would not be able to access.

What Did We Accomplish in 2017?

More than **300 individuals** participated and accessed over **3,000 free services**
Over **2,500 personal items** were distributed
Over **98%** of participants said they would participate again

Services Provided at PHC Buffalo
