## **Project Homeless Connect**

(PHC) is a one stop model of delivering services to people experiencing or at risk of experiencing homelessness. PHC began in San Francisco in 2004 and has grown into an international best practice model. This program has shown positive results in getting people connected to the community while providing them services they otherwise

## **What Did We Accomplish in 2018?**

**More than 300 participants accessed over 3,000 services and received more than 2,500 personal items**, including soap, shampoo, deodorant, laundry detergent, hats, gloves and other essential clothing. **Over 98%** of participants said they would participate again

## **Services Provided at PHC Buffalo**

Local agencies will provide a wide range of **free services** including:

- Credit counseling
- Dental Care and Referrals
- Elder Services
- Employment/Job Readiness Counseling
- Emergency Shelter
- Legal Services
- Foreclosure Prevention
- Health Screenings
- HIV/AIDS Testing
- Mental Health Referrals
- Permanent housing opportunities
- Substance Abuse Services
- Services for those with disabilities
- Social Security Benefits Assistance
- Veterans benefits information
